

North Carolina residents with a print disability could qualify to receive free accessible books as well as additional accessible library services.

A print disability may be a visual impairment, a physical impairment that makes holding a book difficult, or a reading disability.

Accessible books come in **audio**, **large print**, and **braille formats**. Additionally, patrons can use their smart phone to download braille and audio books through the **BARD** app.

Accessible library services include reader advisory services, machine repair, library technology support, as well as state-wide library programs.
