

1980 PB82 - Age of Householder by Family Income

1980 PB92 - Income of Unrelated Individuals 15 and Over by Age and Sex

This report was tabulated by staff in the Office of State Budget and Management from the 1980 Census summary tape file 4, which is based on sample, as opposed to complete-count, data.

PB82 reports the age of householder by family income in 1979.

Income is total money income received in calendar year 1979.

Family income is the sum of money income for all family members in the household.

Table PB82 columns:

1. Family income range
2. Householders age 15-24
3. Householders age 25-34
4. Householders age 35-44
5. Householders age 45-54
6. Householders age 55-59
7. Householders age 60-64
8. Householders age 65 and over

PB92 reports the sex by age by income in 1979 for unrelated individuals 15 years and over.

An unrelated individual is

- (1) A householder living alone or with nonrelatives,
- (2) A household member who is not related to the householder, or
- (3) A person living in group quarters who is not an inmate of an institution.

Table PB92 columns:

1. Person income range
2. Unrelated individuals, males 15-64
3. Unrelated individuals, males 65 and over
4. Unrelated individuals, females 15-64
5. Unrelated individuals, females 65 and over
