


LINC: LOG INTO NORTH CAROLINA <http://linc.state.nc.us>

BASICS The LINC database uses frames, which are several "windows" within one browser window. Each operates somewhat independently of the others in terms of scrolling--if you scroll up and down in one frame the others will remain stationary--but if you make a change in one frame, it causes changes in the others. Think of it like cause and effect: if you flip a light switch on, the ceiling light comes on. When you make certain choices in one frame, that will have specific effects in the other frames.

ESTIMATES

- Municipalities, counties, and state
- Counties/State 1980-2011 (single years)
Some additional coverage back to 1970
- NO age, race, gender breakdowns

PROJECTIONS

- No municipalities – boundaries not stable
- Demographic breakdowns through 2030 (single year) and 2030 (various years)
- Annual data through 2030
- State level population by single age through 2030
- Growth Tables and maps by decade through 2030
- Breakdowns by age, race (white and non-white), and gender.
