For the 20__/20__ school year, please follow these guidelines for the continued loan of SLNC Accessible Books & Library Services (formerly the NC Library for the Blind & Physically Handicapped) books and equipment:

1. Please list on the attached form all students eligible for our service this year.
2. Call our toll-free number, 1-888-388-2460, if you need books or equipment or to update the grade level for your students.
3. If you have no students eligible for service this year, please return any equipment and books still on loan to you from our library. If you are unsure what is loaned to you, please call us.

Our eligibility requirements and list of competent authorities have changed, so that those with reading/learning disabilities can be certified by people such as educators, social workers, case workers, counselors, rehabilitation teachers, certified reading specialists, school psychologists, superintendents, or librarians.

Please complete the remainder of this form and, as necessary, the enclosed list. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for returning the forms. No postage is necessary.
