Fast Facts



84 library systems with **393** locations.



56% or nearly **6 million** NC residents are active **library users**.



Library users **borrowed** just under **64 million** items.



43% libraries have **eliminated overdue fees** providing more equitable access.



Public libraries created more than **3,000 full-time equivalent jobs**.

Our impact

Public libraries across North Carolina continued to see more residents return to library buildings after the pandemic. **In-person library visits increased 76%** to over 15 million total visits. Library **computer usage increased over 100%** even while many libraries continue to loan hotspots and devices for home use.

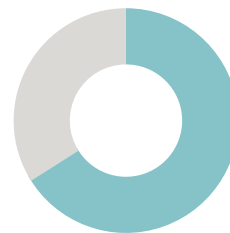
Library programs also continue to see increases in attendance for all age groups. Overall, **program attendance increased 66%** with nearly 19 attendees per program on average.

Libraries do all this and more with an average funding of \$23 per resident!

Library databases were accessed **19 million** times in the last year for test prep, language learning, or even learning auto and home repair.



1.6 million people attended one of **85,000** programs offered by libraries across the state.

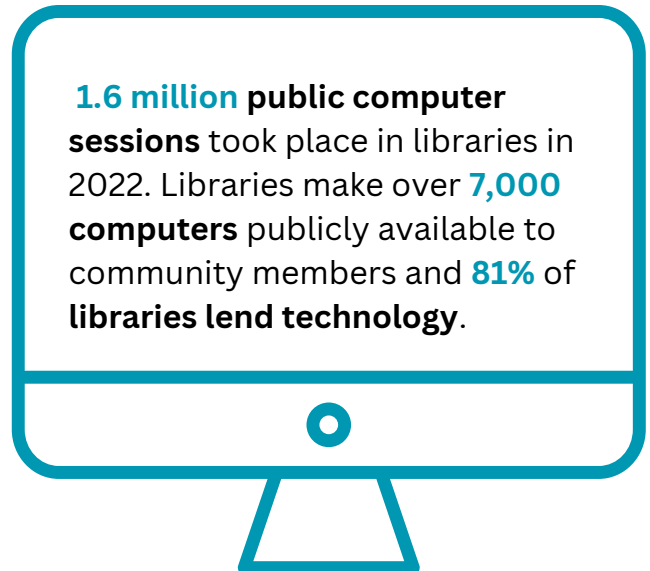
Libraries connect communities to technology

89% of libraries offer **free one-on-one technology assistance** helping residents access, use and build confidence in their digital skills.

Over half of NC Libraries offer access to **Northstar** where residents can test and build their technology skillset.



1.6 million public computer sessions took place in libraries in 2022. Libraries make over **7,000** computers publicly available to community members and **81%** of libraries lend technology.
