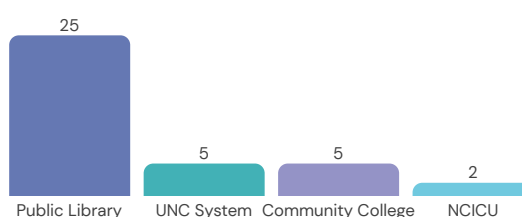

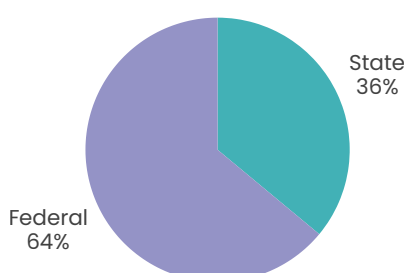

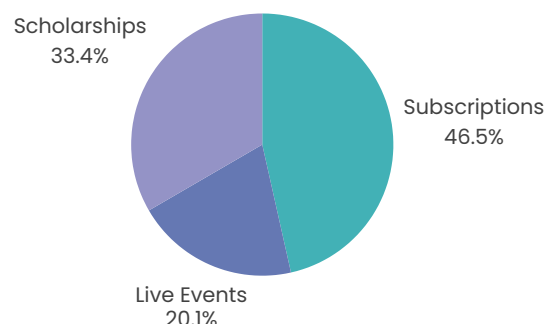
FUNDING
