35.5 million visits were made to public libraries last year. That's more than 3 visits per NC resident.

Libraries offer something for everyone. In fact, **over half** of all North Carolinians are active library users. Last year libraries were open nearly 100,000 hours, answered 6.7 million questions and loaned 52.5 million items.
